Papers will be scheduled at 15-minute for "Oral standard" presentations. Plan to leave 2 minutes for transition to the next speaker, since participants should have the possibility to go between parallel sessions.

Poster Guidelines

The maximum poster size requested is ICBDR FORMAT (60 cm \times 80 cm - W x H) in portrait format. The material required to display your posters will be provided onsite.

Preparation of Visuals

The poster must contain the following sections:

- Title of the contribution
- Author list and detailed contacts, corresponding author
- Context of the work
- Materials and Methods
- Results and Discussion
- Conclusions and Perspectives
- Selected literature references
- Acknowledgments (optional)
